

## CHICAGO BASEBALL MUSEUM

January 19, 2005 marked the first official advisory board meeting for the proposed Chicago Baseball Museum. Business leaders, legislators, former ballplayers, lawyers, architects, realtors, and marketing specialists joined



together to discuss a working feasibility study headed by the museum's president Dr. David Fletcher and vice president, Linda Williamson.

Though Museum plans are in the preliminary stages, enthusiasm is high.

The Museum is slated to incorporate information and exhibits relating to the Chicago Cubs, Chicago White Sox, Negro Leagues, Women's Leagues, 16-



inch softball, and baseball broadcasting in Chicago. Many sites have been proposed to host the museum, but 325 N. LaSalle is currently the leading candidate. This site is ideal because it is centrally located within the city, bridges the north and south side

Major League teams, provides room for expansion, and is proximate to public transportation, among many other reasons.
