

2004 Society for American Baseball Research (SABR) Convention
July 15 – 18, 2004

Members of the ClearBuck.com campaign recently attended the Society for American Baseball Research annual convention in Cincinnati, Ohio. A number of expert panelists, speakers, authors, historians and genuine baseball fans from around the country gathered for a weekend-long discussion of baseball in America.


Of particular interest to our campaign members, was the 1919 World Series panel, organized by fellow Black Sox researcher and writer, Gene Carney. Other panelists included, Jim Sandoval, history teacher and freelance writer; Daniel A. Nathan, author of *Saying It's So: A Cultural History of the Black Sox Scandal* (2003); David Fleitz, author of *Shoeless Joe: The Life and Times of Joe Jackson* (2001) and moderator Alan Schwarz, senior writer of *Baseball America* magazine and weekly columnist for ESPN.com. The panel compared the talent of the White Sox team to that of the Reds, the societal atmosphere and influences in 1919, and controversies and contradictions of the research uncovered of the 1919 Black Sox scandal.

Between luncheons and seminars, members of the ClearBuck.com campaign conducted research at the Cincinnati Library and the Cincinnati Historical Society's Research Library. The greatest find was an article printed on October 10, 1919 by Ross Tenney of the Cincinnati Post. He describes Buck Weaver as the hero for the White Sox team for his hard-fought play and his unwavering positive spirit.
